

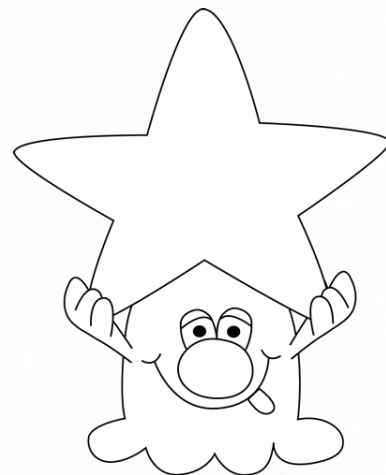
# Class Rules & Discipline Policy

Below you will find a copy of our Kindergarten class rules. As part of the behavior management in our classroom, we will be using a clip chart behavior system. Each day all students will have their name begin in the Ready to Learn circle. Throughout the day, if the student demonstrates role-model behavior or goes above and beyond, he/she will be asked to move their magnet to the blue Mon-STAR circle. At the end of the day, all students who's magnets are in the blue Mon-STAR will receive their daily behavior sticker and a special reward. All students who remain in the green Ready to Learn circle, will receive their daily behavior sticker. Once students have 5 stickers on their chart, they will be given the opportunity to choose from our Prize Box.

Contrastingly, if a student is off-task or is making unwise choices, their magnet will be moved down to the "Slow Down" circle resulting in the loss of 5 minutes of recess. If the poor behavior continues, then the students will be asked to move their magnet to the red "Teacher's Choice" circle. A consequence will be chosen based on the rule that was broken. In the event that the bad choices happen again, the student's magnet will be moved to the black "Principal Visit / Parent Contact" circle. At this time, parents will be notified immediately of the child's behavior.

## CLASS RULES

- Listening Bodies - I will listen and follow directions.
- Raised Hands - I will raise my hand to share ideas.
- Quiet Mouths - I will use a soft voice.
- Walking Feet - I will walk in school to be safe.
- Helping Hands - I will use my hands for helping, not hurting.
- Caring Hearts - I will use kind words.
